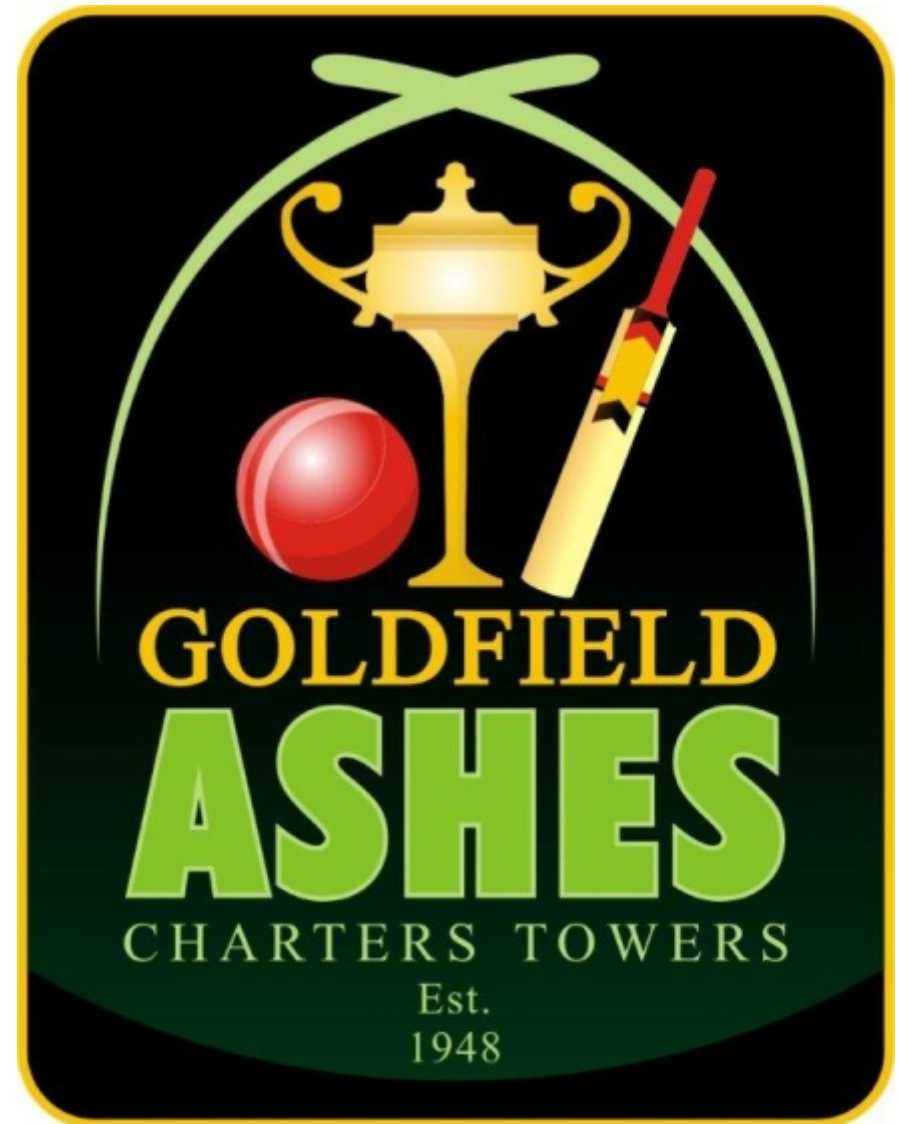

FOREWORD

It is with much pleasure that the Charters Towers Cricket Association once again invite teams, both old and new, to participate in the Goldfield Ashes Cricket Carnival to be conducted over the weekend of the 23rd, 24th and 25th January, 2010.

The number of wickets available to us will once again determine the number of teams we will be able to accommodate. We must therefore stress that if teams have to be balloted out, those which have not paid their nomination fee when submitting their nomination will be the first to go.

The Carnival next year will be conducted along similar lines to that of this year, with the A1, A2 and B1 Grades playing a 50-over competition, and the B2, Social Grades and Ladies' Playing a restricted 35-over competition.

To overcome the problem of A Grade cricketers competing in the B2 and Social grades, and consequently dominating the games, the rules of these grades have been amended, placing restrictions on both batting and bowling. Batsmen will have to retire at the completion of 50 runs and no bowler will be allowed to bowl more than five overs (B2) and four overs (Social) in any one innings. Complete details of the rules in these grades will appear in the Goldfield Ashes program.

OBJECTIVE OF CARNIVAL

The objective of this Carnival is to bring together from near and far our fellow cricketers to participate with good sportsmanship and friendly rivalry in the King of Games. We welcome you and hope that your stay is a very enjoyable one. AND REMEMBER...this carnival has been organised and presented for your particular enjoyment. You can help maintain the high reputation it now enjoys by conducting yourself with propriety at all times during the weekend.

ACCOMMODATION & CATERING

Most teams which compete in the Goldfield Ashes now make their own arrangements for accommodation and catering.

Hotel and motel accommodation is usually booked out 12 months in advance. Many teams now bring their own camping equipment and camp. The Golf Club, Dalrymple and Charters Towers Caravan Park plus Aussie Outback Oasis Cabin & Van Village all have showers, toilets and electricity available, at very reasonable tariffs. The system has worked very well in the past years, and we advise all new teams to think along these lines when considering a nomination for the Carnival.

Accommodation should be available at these if the bookings are made early enough. We would also advise all teams to confirm their bookings as soon as possible to avoid any possible disappointments. Teams which camp at any of the sporting clubs are asked to please confirm these arrangements with the respective Clubs.

All teams nominating for our 2010 Carnival will once again be made most welcome, and we trust that your behaviour both on and off the field will continue to be as good as it has been in the past years.

HEADQUARTERS

Headquarters for the conduct of the 2010 Goldfield Ashes Carnival will be at the Goldfields Sporting Complex in York Street.

Officials of the Goldfield Ashes Committee will be in attendance at the Club House on the Friday afternoon, and throughout the weekend, to answer any query, and to attend to the various needs of the teams.

Souvenir merchandise and a food stall will again be available at this Carnival. Both stalls will be open throughout the weekend.

BROOMS & BALLS

Teams nominated in the B2 and Social Grades now play with a 156g moulded composition ball as games are now played on concrete pitches with no mat covering. Teams nominated in the A1, A2 and B1 Grades will continue to play with a 156g 2-piece leather ball.

New balls for each day's play are provided by the Carnival Committee as part of each team's nomination fee. These balls will be available for collection at the beginning of each day's play along with score sheets.

Each team's cricket equipment should also include a straw broom to keep mats/concrete wickets clean during play.

MATS & PEGS

Mats and pegs will no longer apply to the B2 and Social grades due to the use of plastic coated balls. Your team's successful nomination in the A1, A2 and B1 Grades will depend on your team being able to supply mats.

All mats will be the responsibility of each team. Each team will be required to lay and collect their mats at each venue at which they play on every day of the Carnival. It is imperative, therefore, that each team supplies at least half a set of mats, clearly marked with the name of the owner.

This Association cannot, and will not, accept responsibility for mats.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the 2010 Goldfield Ashes Carnival will close on **FRIDAY 27th NOVEMBER 2009**.

Unless advised otherwise, **ALL NOMINATIONS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ACCEPTED. UNLESS NOTIFIED IN WRITING.** However, nominations will **NOT** be acknowledged in writing until after the Grading Committee meet on Monday, 11th January 2010.
